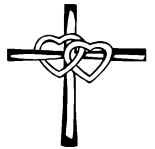
The Offertory Collection last weekend was \$12,679. Thank you very much. The second collection **this** weekend is for the **Church in Latin America**.

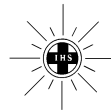

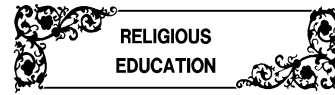
