### New England CYO Boys Basketball Champions

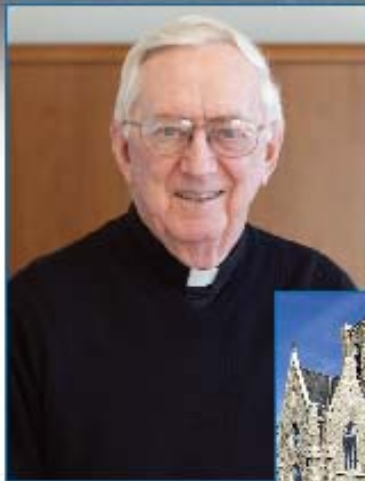
