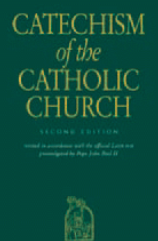
**American Black and Indian Missions Collection** - Next week's second collection supports programs for Black and Native American populations. Proceeds from this collection are distributed as grants to dioceses supporting and strengthening evangelization programs, which would otherwise be in danger of disappearing among the Black, American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut communities of the United States.

**This summer Nick is leading an 8-part adult catechetical series which addresses questions central to the Catholic faith.** In previous sessions Nick discussed the Church's teaching on evolution and the Sacraments. Using the "Catechism of the Catholic Church" as a guide, Nick begins each session with a 10-15 minute-long presentation on a particular topic, followed by 10-15 minutes of questions and discussion. Refreshments are provided at the end of each session. The presentations take place in the Parish

Center immediately following the 9 A.M. Mass on the following Sundays: July 11, July 18, July 25, August 1, August 8 and August 15. The remaining questions, which will be addressed in order, are: 1) **Are there proofs for God's existence?** 2) **Who and what are angels?** 3) **Can prayer change the future?** 4) **Are faith and reason compatible?** 5) **What and where are heaven and hell?** 6) **How can Mary be the Mother of God?** *Please know that you are welcome to attend any of the sessions. It is not required that you attend all of them.*
