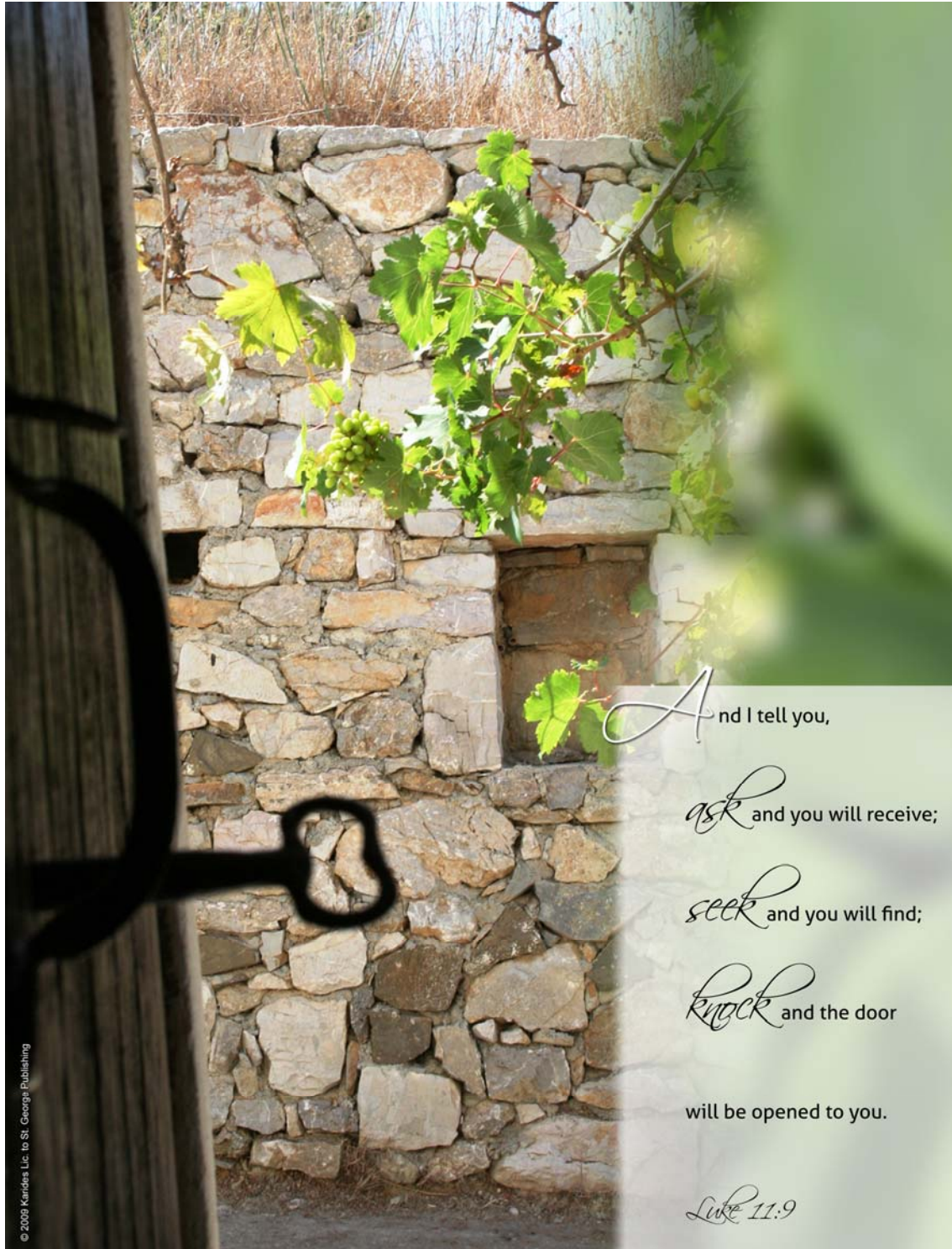

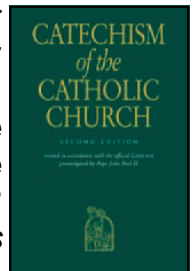

Nicolas Twaalfhoven, our Seminarian Intern, is continuing an 8-part **adult catechetical series which addresses questions central to the Catholic faith.** In previous sessions Nick discussed the Church's teaching on evolution, the Sacraments, the existence of God and angels. Using the "Catechism of the Catholic Church" as a guide, Nick begins each session with a 10-15 minute-long presentation on a particular topic, followed by 10-15 minutes of questions and discussion. Refreshments are provided at the end of each session. The presentations take place in the Parish Center immediately following the 9 A.M. Mass on the following Sundays: July 25, August 1, August 8 and August 15. The remaining questions, which will be addressed in order, are: 1) **Can prayer change the future?** 2) **Are faith and reason compatible?** 3) **What and where are heaven and hell?** 4) **How can Mary be the Mother of God?**



Please know that you are welcome to attend any of the sessions. It is not required that you attend all of them.
